

## MIRACLE REPORTING

### FIRST STEPS IN REPORTING A MIRACLE CASE

Submit a report to the Director of Blessed Marianne's Cause with the following information:

#### Health Questions

- a. Symptoms of the disease or other illness
- b. Diagnosis and prognosis given by the physician --in other words, how critical was the illness
- c. Description of the cure
- d. Do you have enough medical data authenticating a complete change in the person's condition--enclose, please, or tell what is available to you. Send on if this is a mailed response
- e. Explain if cure was instantaneous or if any way unusual in timing
- f. Tell if the cure is considered permanent
- g. Are there medical charts available for after the time of the cure

If sufficient information is included, we then will ask the Medical Expert for Blessed Marianne's Cause to give an opinion whether or not there is a medical explanation for the cure. Further consultation is done by the Medical Expert with physicians familiar with the specific illness with which the cured person was afflicted. If a promising case, at this time more records and other information will be requested in preparation for a Tribunal Inquiry.

#### Intercessory Questions

- a. How and when did prayer to Blessed Marianne for her intercession begin
- b. Were other intercessors invoked by the ones presenting the miracle case
- c. Who is credited by the ones reporting the case as the intercessor and why

If you find it more convenient, these beginning questions can be answered by e-mail in the form of response you prefer.

It is to be understood that there are real miracles happening, in our opinion, that cannot be proved because of lack of sufficient verification. We, in no way, are determining that the person cured was not the recipient of a miracle. We seek a miracle case that can be authenticated for the reason this is the only kind acceptable at the Vatican for the advancement of Blessed Marianne's Cause.
